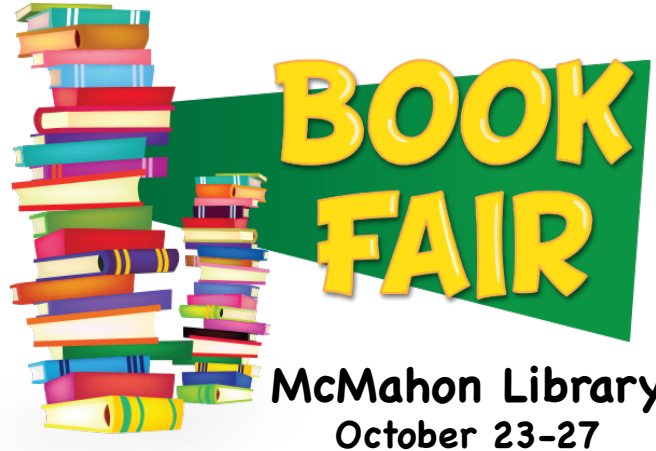
PTO NEWS
